The Club is still in the planning phase of our Fall Rally Trial- October 31st & November 1st.

Here are notes from the meeting that Sally Hensen was nice enough to share.

Ellen Beris presented a detailed description of COVID-19 precautions which were in place at the recent Orlando and IPOC rally trials. It was decided that the following precautions should be implemented at the Lake Eustis rally trials in November.

- All state/county guidelines to be followed.
- All persons entering the building must wear a mask and temperatures will be taken.
- Masks will be supplied to those who do not have one.
- A sticker will be issued to each person upon entry.
- A Covid-19 waiver will be included in the premium. It must be signed and presented upon entering the building or one must be signed at that time.
- An envelope containing armbands and necessary information for each exhibitor will be at the entry table.
- Masks to be worn in the building but not required when exhibiting.

Ellen agreed to be in charge of the necessary Covid -19 precautions and instruct workers.

Pens for signing waivers need to be supplied. Gene Everson suggested inexpensive pens with the Lake Eustis name on them. Exhibitors to keep their pens.

Discussion regarding limiting entries for the trials - several Board Members, who had never seen the MADTA building, wish to look at the space before any decision can be made about entries. Sally Hensen will make arrangements for a meeting at the building on Sunday, July 12 at noon.
