PLEASE READ:

1. No emailed entries will be accepted for these trials. All entries must be sent snail mail, be hand-delivered, or entered through MB-F (Infodog). **Be aware that Monday, October 12 is a holiday and there is no mail service. Also, MB-F will not accept trial entries after noon on Friday, October 9. There is an additional \$15.00 charge (above their usual charges) for entering independent trials with show secretaries through MB-F.**
2. Masks will be required at all times in the building, except that masks will be optional while in the ring.
3. You will be required to sign the waiver in this premium list and bring it to the trial. **DO NOT** mail the waiver with your entry!
4. 6' x 6' crating spaces will be marked. Bring your own chair. No chairs will be available.
5. Course maps will be emailed after 6:00 p.m. the evening before the trial. You must supply an email address on your entry form. Please write legibly.
6. Upon arrival, your temperature will be checked, you will turn in your signed waiver, sign in, and pick up the envelope with your armbands for the weekend.
7. Remember to check in with the table steward before your class.
8. There will be no food available on-site. There are several fast food restaurants on Highway 40 east and west of I-75.
9. These trials are not open to the public.

Entry Rules: Entries close at 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 14, 2020, after which entries cannot be accepted, changed, or canceled. Entries must be signed by owner or agent and submitted with fees ONLY on the standard AKC entry form. Entry Fees for Rally include the AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 for each first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry.

Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted.

Express or overnight entries MUST be marked "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED."

Acknowledgement of receipt of entry will be made by email. If you do not receive email confirmation that your entry was received within a reasonable time after mailing it, notify the Trial Secretary. Inform the Secretary if you do not have email. **Allow several days for first class mail. Late entries cannot be accepted per AKC rules.**

Entry confirmations, judging schedules, and directions to the show site will be emailed no later than 10 days before the trials. If conditions at that time require cancellation of the trials, you will be notified by email.

You MUST indicate jump height for all classes which require jumps.

Saturday: Rally entries will be ordered by jump height, in descending order beginning with 16 inches.

Sunday: Rally entries will be ordered by jump height, in ascending order beginning with 4 inches.

Dimensions of the Rally Ring will be 40' x 50'.

Directions to show site:

From the North: From I-75 go West (right) onto Highway 40. (Exit 352) Go approximately 2.7 miles. Just past J & J Tack Shack (on the right side of the road) is NW 68th Ave (Landmark in BOB's TIRE) Turn right onto NW 68th Ave. Proceed to the next road on right, NW 3rd Place, turn right and the facility will be down at the end of the road.

From the South: From I-75 go West (left) onto Highway 40. (Exit 352) Exit 352 Go approximately 2.7 Miles. Just past J & J Tack Shack (on the right side of the road) is NW 68th Ave (Landmark is BOB's TIRE) Turn right onto NW 68th Ave. Proceed to the next road on right, NW 3rd Place, turn right and the facility will be down at the end of the road.

Building is smoke free. No dogs will be allowed in the ring for practice at any time. No dogs may be left in the building overnight. Please bring your own chairs. Each exhibitor will have a 6' by 6' area for their chair and crating.

Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club make it impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be granted.

Bitches that come into season after the closing date for entries may have the entry fee refunded less \$5.00 per class upon written request of the owner or handler before the start of judging on the day of the trial.

TRANSFERS: A transfer may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the handler and dog are eligible for the class. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit. Transfers will be accepted prior to the day of the trial. Transfer forms are available on the AKC website or from the trial secretary.

You MUST supply a jump height for the transfer.

AKC, LEKC, Inc., the Trial Chairperson, Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, the City of Ocala, and the Marion Alachua Dog Training Association assume no responsibility for any loss damage, injury, or theft sustained by any person or to any dogs or property.

Exhibitors and agents will be responsible for keeping the premises clean. Please help us remain welcome and **clean up after your dog** at all times. Please do not allow dogs to urinate or mark on the buildings. Please use the trash cans provided at the elimination area. Thank you for your cooperation.

LEKC AKC events are held according to, and governed by, AKC rules and regulations. COVID-19 Pandemic Consent and Release Form

I, the undersigned, hereby acknowledge that I am voluntarily participating in the trials hosted by the Lake Eustis Kennel Club, Inc. (hereafter referred to as "LEKC") at the properties of the Marion Alachua Dog Training Association, Inc. ("MADTA"), 6600 NW 3rd Place, Ocala, FL 34482. I acknowledge that there are risks involved in bringing my dog into contact with other dogs, and in my participation in LEKC functions and events, including the risk of my dog or myself contracting Coronavirus and/or Covid-19, other communicable disease and the risk of physical injury arising from an altercation with another dog, the condition of the training premises and grounds, and a wide range of other factors. I also understand that participation in such programs is not without risk to myself, members of my family who may attend, or my dog, because some of the dogs to which I will be exposed may be difficult to control and may be the cause of injury even when handled with the greatest amount of care. While the LEKC and Landlord (MADTA) may take steps to reduce those risks, I acknowledge that they cannot, and do not, guarantee that they will be eliminated. I understand the COVID-19 virus has a long incubation period during which carriers of the virus may not show symptoms and still be highly contagious. I also understand that it is impossible to determine who may have the virus and who does not given the current limits in virus testing. By signing below, I agree, to do the following while present on the property of the Landlord (MADTA):

- **Maintain a distance of at least six (6) feet from all other attendees of LEKC-hosted events who are not members of my household**
- **Except when eating or drinking, wear a mask over my nose and mouth when I am not able to maintain a distance of at least six (6) feet from all other attendees of LEKC-hosted events who are not members of my household**
- **Avoid sneezing or coughing around others and cover my mouth when I do cough or sneeze. Use a tissue to cover my nose and mouth, and throw used tissues in a trash can. If a tissue is not available, I will cough or sneeze into my elbow – not my hands. I will immediately wash my hands afterwards**

In consideration of and as inducement to the acceptance of my trial entry or for being permitted to participate in or observe any LEKC-hosted competition events, I hereby agree that I, my heirs, guardians, legal representatives, successors and assigns will not, and shall not, make a claim against, sue, attach the property of or prosecute LEKC, its officers, members, agents, employees, volunteers or guests, and/or the Landlord (MADTA), or any of them, for any injuries, illness or damage resulting to me, my animal(s) or my property from the negligence or other acts, however caused, by any member, agent, employee, volunteer, guest or contractor of LEKC and/or Landlord (MADTA), or any one of them, or as the result of my participation in any LEKC-hosted activities. In addition, I hereby release and discharge LEKC and/or its members from all actions, claims, or demands I, my heirs, distributees, assigns, guardians, or legal representatives now have or may in the future have for injury, illness or damage resulting from my participation in this activity.

I also agree to indemnify and hold Landlord (MADTA) and its members, employees, clients, agents, guests and volunteers harmless from any and all claims, or claim made by any member of any family or any other person accompanying me to any activity or function as a result of any action by any dog or person, including my own, and I expressly assume the risk of such damage, illness or injury resulting from the action of any dog or person while attending any function while on the training grounds or the surrounding area thereto including, but not limited to, 6600 NW 3rd Place, Ocala, Florida, and I agree to indemnify and hold harmless any and all legal owners of said identified property. 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
 2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, A or B division.
 3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
 4. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
